



NOTICE OF REGATTA

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regattas will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Competitors may switch among Standard, Radial, or 4.7 rigs, on land only. All sails used must match the registered sail number.
- 1.3 The organizing authority may issue colored bands to be applied to the mast.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Members of the ILCA who have reached the age of 35 by the first day of each regatta may enter those regattas.

3. Registration and Fees

- 3.1 Registration and entry fees must be received by USSCMC no later than Monday, February 1, 2010. The entry fee is \$90.00.
- 3.2 All registrations received between February 2nd and February 5th will be charged a \$25 late fee. All registrations received on the day of the event will be subject to an additional \$15 late fee for a total of \$130.
- 3.3 On-site check-in and late registration will be held on Friday 5 February and Saturday 6 February. See 'Schedule of Events'.

- 4.2 Four races per day will be scheduled.
On the final day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1500.

6. Inspection and Measurement

Boats, gear, and sails may be inspected at any time for conformance to Class Rules.

7. Sailing Instructions

8. Sailing Area

Racing will take place on the Indian River
Directly east of the Sailing Center

9. Courses

Courses are expected to be windward-leeward or triangle as shown in the sailing instructions. Additional courses may be posted on the Official Notice board at USSCMC.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 A boat's worst score will be excluded, when five or more races have been completed. This changes A2.
- 10.3 The NA Masters handicap system will be used to score the overall series.

For each race:

- Apprentices - add 3 points
- Masters - add 2 points
- Grand Masters - add 1 point
- Great Grand Masters - add 0.

11. Prizes

The following trophies will be presented:

- 1st Overall, 1st
- Apprentice Master, 1st-3rd
- Master, 1st-3rd
- Grand Master, 1st-3rd
- Great Grand Master, 1st-3rd
- Woman, 1st

12. Safety

All competitors shall wear government approved life jackets at all times while on the water. Failure to do so is protestable only by Race Committee.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor Race Committee will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
